



SCHOOL DAY RULES AND REGULATIONS

All chaperones must read the Rules and Regulations before attending the Faire.

Upon Arrival- students may not exit the bus until a school representative has reviewed the Rules and Regulations with them. Students should be assigned their chaperones before exiting the bus. Chaperones should be given the admission tickets for all members of their group to turn in at the front gate. Busses may arrive as early as 9 a.m. The gates will open at 9:30 a.m.

Groups and Chaperones- students must be divided into groups to avoid traffic flow problems and ensure proper supervision. Elementary students must be divided into groups of 6 and high school groups of 10. There must be one adult chaperone with each group at all times.

Additional Chaperones- all chaperones must have a ticket pre-purchased from Sheridan Sechter and Associates. There will be no ticket sales at the Faire Box Office on School Days. No coupons or weekend promotional tickets will be accepted on School Days. The general public is not admitted on School Days.

Identification- for identification, all students are required to wear a nametag, complete with the school's name and the student's name.

Guest Relations Booth- may be found inside the Front Gate. Lost children and items will be brought here.

Autographs- please do not allow your students to ask for autographs from the performers. Unfortunately, this prevents the performers from being able to interact with all students.

Shoplifting- anyone found shoplifting or damaging Faire property ***will be prosecuted!*** These are serious offenses and will not be tolerated.

Weapons- no weapons of any kind are allowed on the Faire site.

Backpacks- no backpacks or tote bags are allowed to be carried by students on the Faire site. A chaperone may carry one bag with the essentials for a group. Very small purses/fanny packs may be used by students for minimal personal necessities only.

SHOW ETIQUETTE

It is imperative that everyone observes the following rules and regulations while watching shows and demonstrations. This is the only way to ensure that everyone can hear the performers and enjoy the show. PLEASE GO OVER THESE RULES WITH YOUR STUDENTS!

1. Give your full attention to the show you are watching. Do not talk with your friends.
2. Treat performers with the courtesy and respect that you would want them to treat you.
3. Do not throw anything at performers on Faire property. Security will escort violators off site.
